315 books, **71** dresses and **30** blankets were distributed to very excited boys and girls in a Galveston shelter during Action Week 2022



In order to ensure the maximum number of students were able to receive clothing, the chapter employed a hybrid method which allowed for in-store shopping for those who could attend shopping days and for Shop and Deliver for those who could not attend

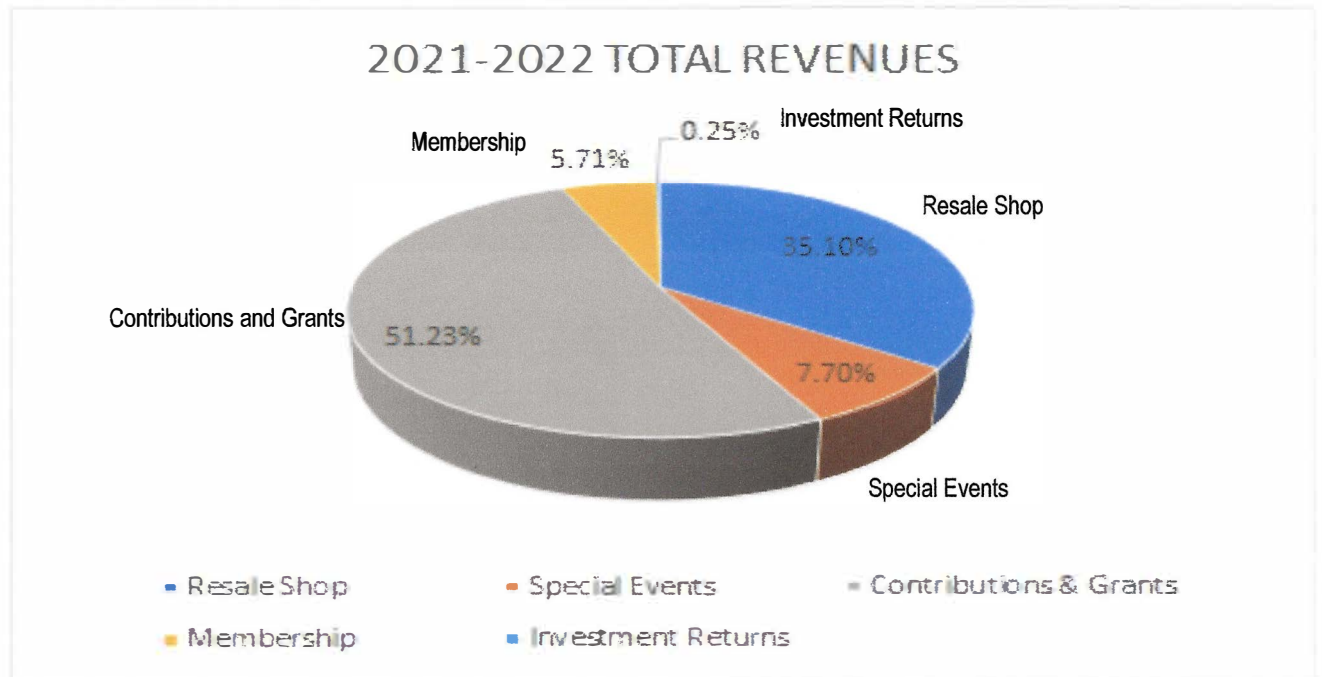

2021-2022 Total Revenues



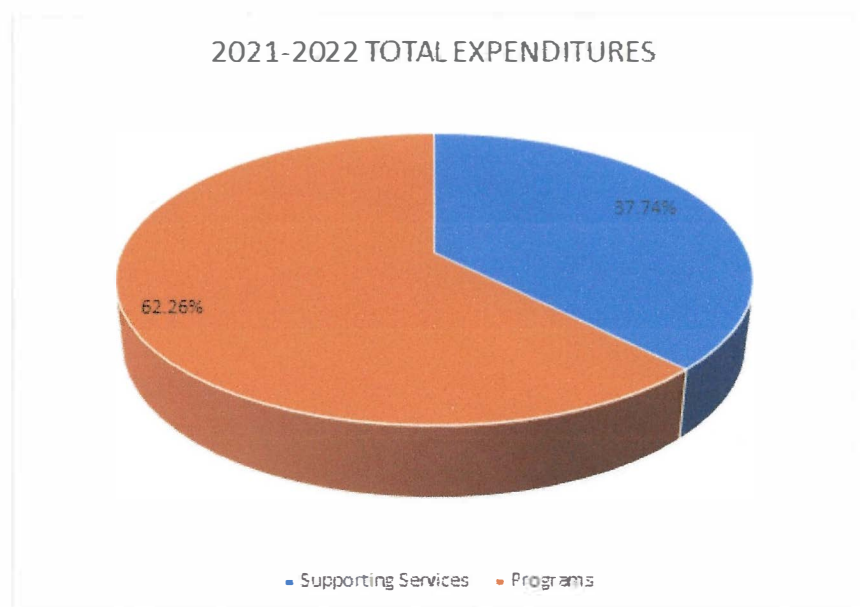
